

The National Diabetes Services Scheme (NDSS) is an initiative of the Australian Government administered by Diabetes Australia.

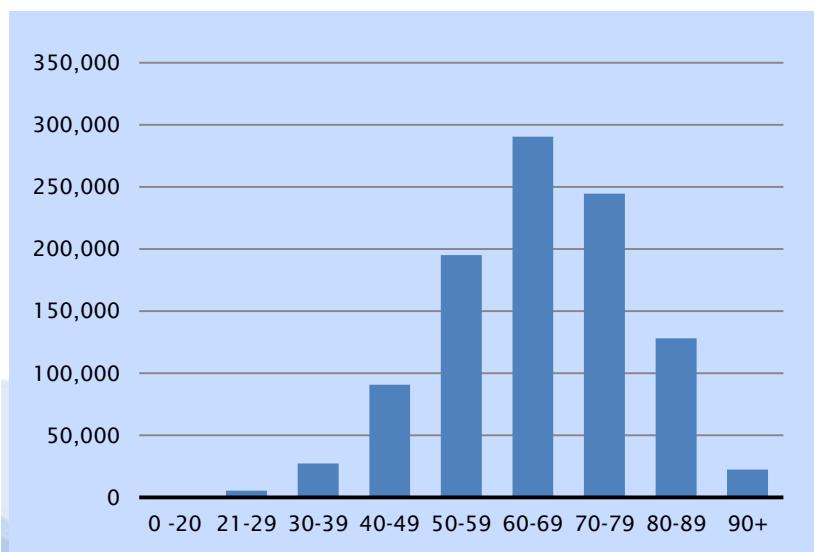

People With Type 2 Diabetes by Age Group



Over the last 12 months 65,794 people with type 2 diabetes were newly registered

Equivalent to 180 new registrants with type 2 diabetes every day

210 people with type 2 diabetes were aged 15 years or under

749 people with type 2 diabetes were aged 16 to 20 years old

5,398 people with type 2 diabetes were aged 21 to 29 years old

286,021 people with type 2 diabetes were aged 40 to 59 years old

685,885 people with type 2 diabetes were aged 60 years or older

236,039 people (23%) with type 2 diabetes required insulin to manage their diabetes
