

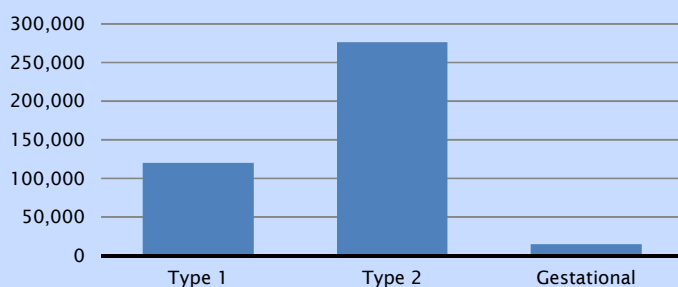
## INSULIN THERAPY

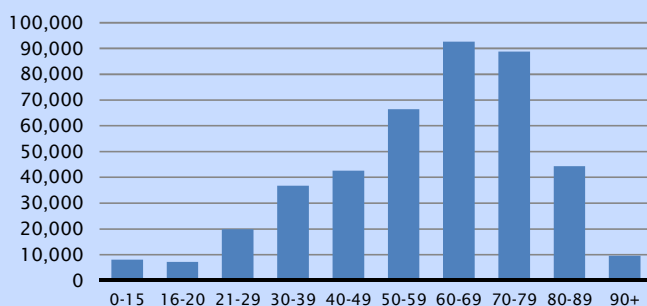
There were 416,269 people with diabetes registered with the NDSS who required insulin therapy. This was 32% of all people with diabetes.

Gestational	14,773	4%	36%
Other	5,113	1%	58%

Over the last 12 months 25,071 people were registered with the NDSS requiring insulin therapy: 3,389 with type 1 diabetes, 6,124 with type 2 diabetes, 14,773 with gestational diabetes, and 785 with other types of diabetes

Equivalent to 69 new insulin requiring registrants every day

66% of all people requiring insulin therapy had type 2 diabetes and 29% had type 1 diabetes

276,369 people with type 2 diabetes required insulin therapy

8,146 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 15 years or under

15,274 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 20 years or under

235,369 people requiring insulin therapy were aged 60 years or older
